Soar By Four Vision Statement


Soar By Four a focused initiative of the Early Learning Coalition of Brevard provides educational programming and resources, encourages community involvement, and builds awareness to increase Brevard County's VPK enrollment.

Soar By Four Goals

- Increase the participation of eligible 4-year-olds to 100% by 2030 Brevard County's current VPK enrollment is 30.41%.
- 100% of children are ready for kindergarten*
- 100% of Florida 3rd graders read at or above grade level*
- Educate the community as to the need for participation and support of early learning programs and the value in preparing the future workforce.
- Engage community leaders, businesses, foundations, and supporters to participate in or lead outreach programs that target all eligible VPK-age children, encouraging their enrollment in the free program.
- Grow child/family/caregiver participation in existing outreach initiatives.

Launch Into Literacy - "Kids who read...succeed!"



Launch into Literacy events are interactive story times held monthly at various locations across the county, targeting critical zip codes including our Melbourne office location.

These fun and engaging events for children and families share age-appropriate educational experiences and exposure to community partners as the storyteller, activity lead, or host. Children explore occupations and experiences (at no cost to their caregiver) and participate in hands-on STEM/STEAM activities.

A recent Launch into Literacy event, recognizing 'Healthcare Heroes', included a themed book reading by an employee of Coastal Health Systems and a 'touch a truck' exploring an ambulance with hands-on guidance by paramedics, and were led in an exercise to learn the importance of 911.

This international program supplies one high-quality free book each month mailed directly to a child at their home.

In one year, we have registered more than 6,000 children in this popular and successful initiative. ELC Brevard, as the affiliate partner, is responsible for this county-wide effort at a current rate of \$31 per child per year.

While free to the children and generously supported by the Imagination Library, the financial support from sponsors and donors is vital.

Help us reach our goal of providing a monthly high-quality free book to ALL 27,000 children age 0-5 in Brevard County.


