## **ELCB Coalition Update**

- Division of Early Learning 2025-2026 Budget discussions being held in Tallahassee. Both the Senate and House are reflecting a decrease for education and early learning funding. Preliminary AELC and statewide initiative to educate and advocate for full funding. AELC (statewide coalition association) 2025 Legislative Priorities attached. UPDATE: June budget projected award reflected 22.9% decrease (estimated \$6.4 million lost); July and August waiting period to measure the revert and reappropriate funding. August 27th final award after AELC Compression Model projections shared with DEL and SR funding reverted to \$8.3 million new award amount (amount includes June monthly SR payment from prior year).
- Legislative Session begins January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026 with ELC Brevard represented during session. Additionally, James Box able to initiate ELCB speaking to the Brevard Legislative Delegation at their meeting on September 30<sup>th</sup> from 2pm to 6pm. The Request to Speak has been submitted in conjunction with Senator Mayfield's office and aide.
- Developing local county, state and federal legislative relationships to increase ELCB awareness, successful outcomes and funding support post-election shift.
   DISCUSSION: Developing multi-year strategic planning and partnership with Results 1<sup>st</sup> to develop a defined Results Framework.
- Age of Learning program, modeled after Palm Beach County success, estimated to begin October 1<sup>st</sup>.
   Presentation to Board September 16, 2025.
- Community Conversation event held August 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Center for Collaboration with 35+ attending.
   Building a series of events as community awareness campaign for legislators and community leaders – next proposed event partnership with WeVenture at FIT as a Business Briefing in Oct/Nov.
- Developing and promoting Soar by Four in conjunction with VPK program assessment models now release from DEL. Initiative includes Launch into
